When bathing in a hot spring, the steam just rises above the rippling water to bathe you in beads of moisture. This is quite similar to the one in the sauna, albeit fully clothed.



Some hot springs have a high water temperature which is capable of boiling eggs in 10 minutes. The water in the spring can warm up to 120 degrees

### **How Are Hot Springs Were Formed?**

Hot springs are formed when water meets the headed rock and produce an emergence of geothermal-heated groundwater from the earth's crust. In this regard, the deep percolation of water into the crust causes it to be heated by the hot rocks. Then heat can be forced to back up under pressure to bubble like a hot spring.



Government at the just ended treasury bill auction announced a set target of GH¢5,400.00 million across the 91, 182 and 364-day bills. However, total bids amounting to GH¢5,529.67 million was received and accepted representing a 2.40% oversubscription of GH¢129.67 million.


